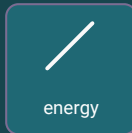




LINE REFERENCE GUIDE

Horizontal = peace, stability
Vertical = strength, growth
Diagonal = speed, energy



Straight vs. Curved

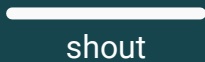
Straight = precise, mechanical

warmth

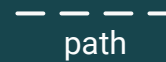
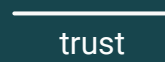
Line Thickness

Thin = luxury, airy
Thick = bold, heavy
Variable = handcrafted



Line Style

Solid = trustworthy
Dashed = process, path
Jagged = tension, excitement



Implied Lines

Eyes follow gaze direction.
Alignment creates invisible order.

Continuity

Point lines toward key info.
Never point toward screen edge.



Closure & Boundaries

Closed lines = shapes.
Color edges = boundaries too.

Same repetition = stable pattern.
